Traditional Grave

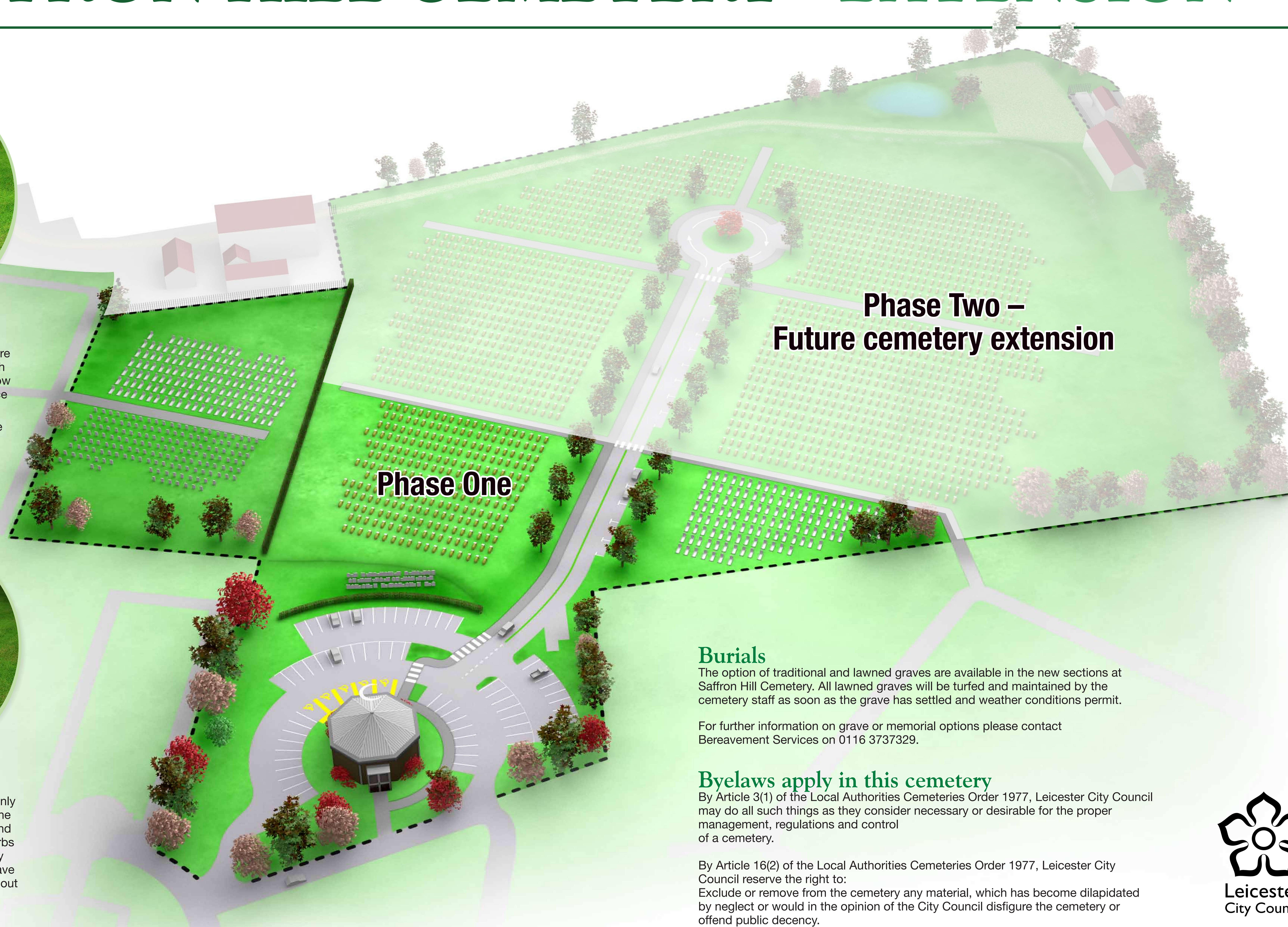
A traditional grave means that you are permitted to place a headstone with kerbs, fence or surrounds and /or sow plants and shrubs in the grave space for which a fee will be charged.

The fee will also apply to any home made fences, kerbs or surrounds placed on a traditional grave.



Lawned Grave

A lawned grave means that you are only permitted to place a headstone on the grave space. The planting of trees and shrubs and the placing of fences, kerbs or surrounds of any material, or any other item is not permitted on the grave and will be removed immediately without further notice.

The option of traditional and lawned graves are available in the new sections at Saffron Hill Cemetery. All lawned graves will be turfed and maintained by the cemetery staff as soon as the grave has settled and weather conditions permit.

Byelaws apply in this cemetery

Exclude or remove from the cemetery any material, which has become dilapidated by neglect or would in the opinion of the City Council disfigure the cemetery or offend public decency.
